#### **Bus Safety Week**



#### Parents and carers - always hold your child's hand

Adults have an important part to play in keeping children safe around roads. School-aged children might seem independent, but they still need a hand around traffic. Remember:

- Always meet your child AT school or the bus stop. NEVER wait on the opposite side of the road and call them across Until they are at least 10 years old, always supervise your child and hold their hand when walking to and from the bus stop or interchange and when crossing the road
- Remind your children to always wait until the bus has gone then use a safe place to cross the r

#### Drivers

Buses can't stop quickly and drivers should:

- Look out for children on footpaths or crossing the street, especially around schools, buses and bus stops
- Leave plenty of space when you're driving or stopped around buses, to keep children safe and improve bus drivers' vision of the road environment
- Remember that lights flash on the front and back of buses to warn motorists that they're picking up or dropping off kids. But whether bus lights are flashing or not, it's best to slow down because when buses stop, children can be nearby
- Also remember to give way to buses pulling out from bus stops and to not merge too closely in front of buses

#### Passengers

Remind your child bus passenger to

- Press the button well before your stop to give the driver plenty time to stop safely
- Wait until the bus has stopped before you get out of your sea
- Take care stepping on and off the bus
- If standing, hold on and keep alert.

#### SAFETY AROUND SCHOOLS **FACT SHEET 4**

Walking and Riding Safely to School



We all want our children to arrive at school safely and on time. But this doesn't have to mean driving them right to the school gate. Walking or riding all or some of the way to school reduces congestion and improves road safety around the school as well as promoting physical activity and reducing our carbon footprint.

- Stop! Look! Listen! Think! every time you cross a road or driveway.
- Stay alert, look up don't get distracted by your phone.
- Use pedestrian crossings where possible.

· Always wear a helmet when riding a bike, scooter or skateboard.

Take extra care around trucks and buses - they can't always see you.

Until your child is at least 8 years old, hold their hand:

- On the footpath
- In the car park.
- When crossing the road.
- Up until at least 10 years old, supervise your child very closely, holding their hand when crossing the road.

If you find walking all the way to school too difficult or too far, drive some of the way and park at least a block or two away and walk with your child the rest of the way.

#### SAFETY DOOR

If you do need to drive, always ensure your children get out of the car through the 'Safety Door', away from passing traffic. This is the rear footpath side door of the car.


